

# How to Post an Auction Item Donation

## Scotties Rock Foundation Auction- Fall 2019

### Step 1. Go to the Scotties Rock Foundation auction site on Facebook

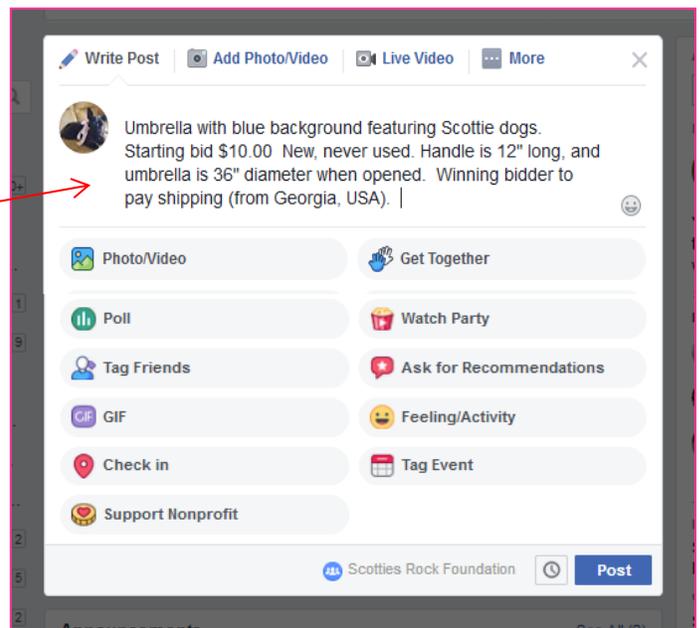

### Step 2. Create the posting for your auction item.

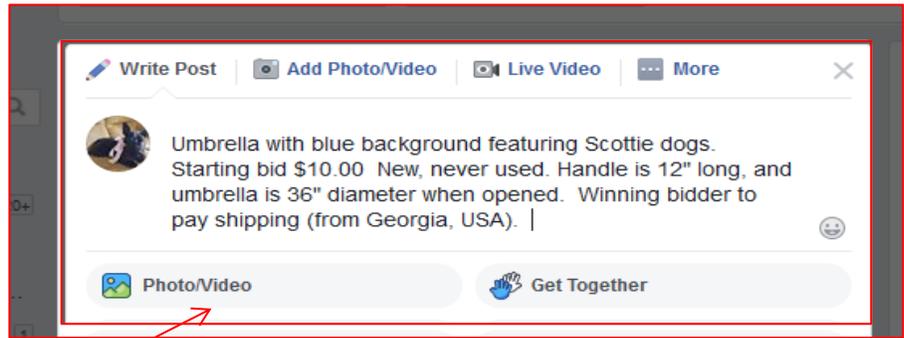


Click on **Write Post**. In the empty box that opens put in the details about your auction item. Be sure to include:

- The name of the item.
- The starting bid.
- Any other descriptive items that will add detail such as size, age (vintage? antique?), condition (new or gently used/gently worn?), color, measurements/size, and so on.
- Information about who will pay the shipping costs, and where the item will be shipped from (State, USA... country if Canada, UK, Australia, etc.)

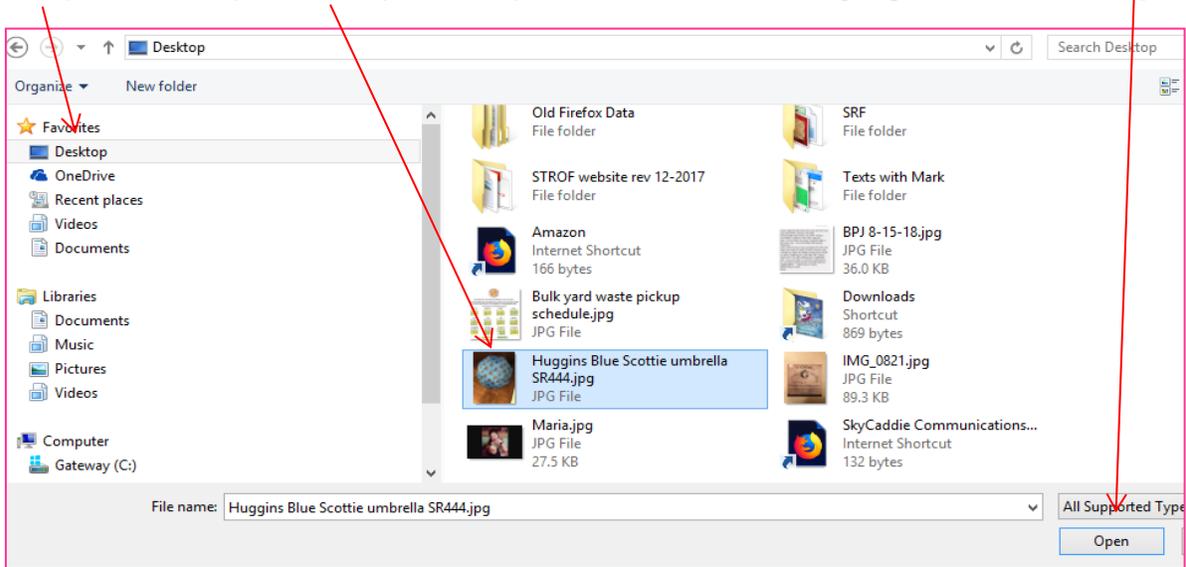


Here is a completed example.



**Step 3. Add the photo of the auction item.**

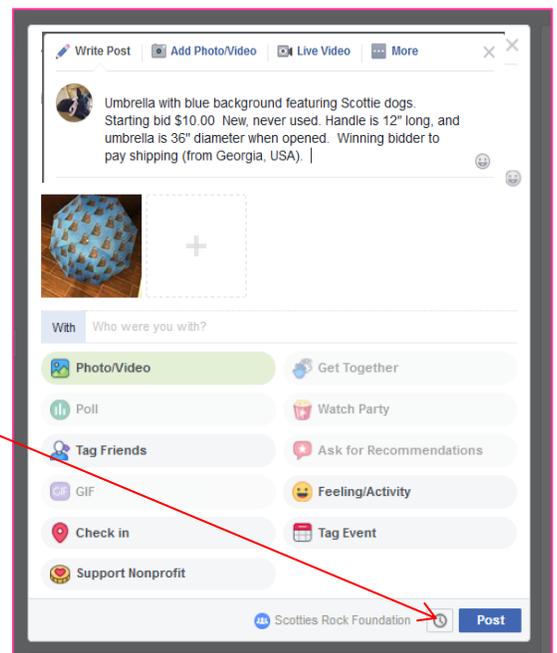
- Click on Photo/Video.
- Search for the item where you saved it on your computer. I saved this umbrella picture on my Desktop. Find the picture on your computer, click it once to highlight it, then click **Open**.



- A small image of your picture is now shown below your item description.

Now, click **Post**

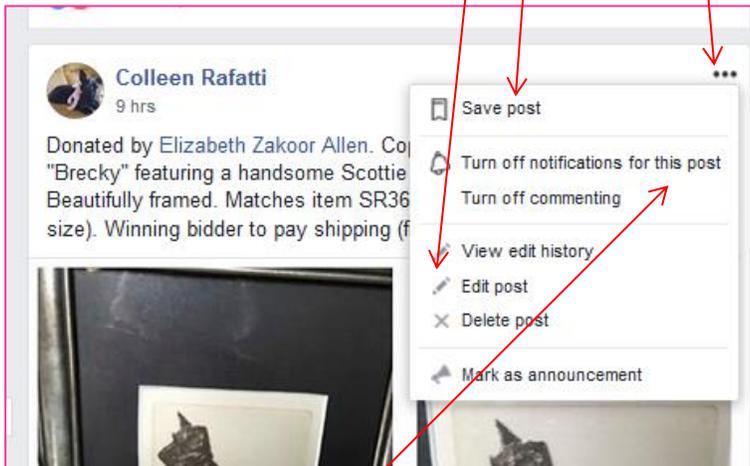


**Step 4. Here is your finished post, visible to visitors to the auction page.**



**NOTE 1:** If there are errors in the post or you want to change something in it, click the three little dots in the upper right corner, then click **Edit post**.

The post reopens on the screen so you can make changes. When finished, click **Save**.



**NOTE 2:** If you do not want to receive a notification in your Facebook every time someone bids or comments on this post, you can click **Turn off notifications** for this post". When finished, click **Save**.

**NOTE 3:** Please be sure to "collage" photos if you have multiple views of an auction donation to show. Do not post more than one photo of the same item- it causes confusion on the auction site for bidders. This is an example of a "collage" photo.



Any Admin will be happy to help you collage your photos!

**NOTE 4:** Sometimes Facebook randomly turns on the Sales Feature, shows your opening bid amount as a fixed sales price. You need to turn that off for all auction postings!

Click on the three dots again, and in the menu that opens click **Turn Sales Feature Off**. (If you don't see that option there look at the bottom of the post... there may be a button there to turn Sales off). Click **Save** post again.



**The deadline for posting donations is 12 Midnight the night before the auction opens (11:59:59PM Central time on October 15, 2019).**

**Contact any Scotties Rock Foundation Admin if you need assistance posting your items.**

**An Admin will automatically add a special code (an "SR number") to your post which helps to identify your item for tracking before, during and after the auction as the first comment for your donation.**
